Please, be punctual for the sessions. We would like to keep with the programme timetable.



Paper sessions:

4/5 papers will be presented in each session. Available time gap for each presentation will be in the range 12-15 minutes + three minutes for questions (session chair will provide you the final details depending on the number of papers presented in each session). The last 15 minutes of each session will be used for a final debate/session conclusion.

Presenting authors are expected to be in the room at least 10 minutes before session start to introduce yourself to the session chair and load and test your presentation file.
